## The 3 M's in MoMMy

*...and she became pregnant and gave birth to a son. When she saw that he was a fine child, she hid him for three months.* Exodus 2:2 NIV

*Pharaoh's daughter said to her, "Take this baby and nurse him for me, and I will pay you." So the woman took the baby and nursed him.* Exodus 2:9 NIV

■ This mother modeled her faith.

*But when she could hide him no longer, she got a papyrus basket for him and coated it with tar and pitch. Then she placed the child in it and put it among the reeds along the bank of the Nile. His sister stood at a distance to see what would happen to him.* Exodus 2:3-4 NIV

*Amram married his father's sister Jochebed, who bore him Aaron and Moses. Amram lived 137 years.* Exodus 6:30 NIV

**By faith** Moses' parents hid him for three months after he was born, because they saw he was no ordinary child, and they were not afraid of the king's edict. **By faith** Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter. Hebrews 11:23-24 NIV
