

Which laws should comprise the 613? And which laws should be listed with highest priority?

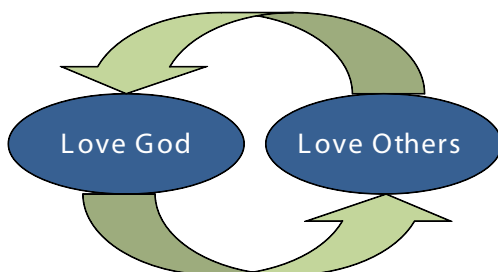
“Of all the commandments, which is the most important?” Mark 12:28 (NIV)
