Churches big on relationship...

- ...embrace people different than themselves (Acts 11:19)
- ...make it easy for outsiders to feel like insiders (11:23)
- ...value wounded and broken people (11:25)
- ...reach out far beyond themselves (11:29)
- ...gain a caring reputation in the community (11:26)
- ...create environments and structures where people can know and be known (13:1)

An MC (missional community)...

- ...connects you to the people and information you need when a need-to-grow or a need-to-know crisis shows up (community)
- ...allows the positive side of peer pressure to do its good work (mentoring)
- ...provides a venue for meaningful service to others (mission)
