Summary of “The Sevens”

1. A command will be given to rebuild Jerusalem.
2. Within 49 (7×7) years of that command, Jerusalem will be rebuilt in spite of the perilous times.
3. After Jerusalem is rebuilt, another 434 (62×7) years will pass until the Messiah/Christ comes to rule.
4. Shortly after the full 483 (69×7) years, the Messiah will be killed, appearing to have accomplished nothing.
5. The temple and city of Jerusalem will then be destroyed once again by an invading ruler.

6. From that point onward Jerusalem will be a center of conflict for an unknown period of time until... the final 7.
7. During the final 7-year period, promises will be made and broken by an imposter ruler... and then the end will come, redemption will be complete, and the “Most Holy One” will rule forever.

The ancient near-eastern calendar year had 360 days. Our Roman calendar has 365 days (366 each leap year).

There were 483 years in the calendar Daniel used, which equals 476 years and 21 days in the calendar we use.

When was the command to rebuild Jerusalem?

– Nisan 445 B.C. (Nehemiah 2:1)

When did Christ enter Jerusalem, only to be “cut off” a week later?

– Nisan 31 A.D. (476 years later)
