



What really is mentoring?

- Mentor, a character in Homer's *Odyssey*, was charged with watching King Odysseus' son while he was at war.
- "One who thinks" (Greek meaning)
- The third most powerful relationship for influencing human behavior, after marriage and extended family.
- Discipleship, apprenticeship, spiritual direction
- A brain to pick, an ear to listen, and a push in the right direction

What does a mentor do?

- A mentor provides a relational covering (shelter) so that you can process the journey. (Acts 9:26–31)
- A mentor is not focused upon himself. (Acts 13:1–3, 6–7, 13, 42–43, 46)
- A mentor is a means of grace and truth. (Acts 15:36–41)
