Title: Promises, Promises

Key Text: 2 Corinthians 1:12–24

For no matter how many promises God has made, they are ‘yes’ in Christ. v.20

- God the Father is the promise maker
- God the Son is the promise fulfiller
- God the Holy Spirit is the proof!

“I have seen that the promises of God are true, for they have been fulfilled in me.” –Charles Spurgeon

Does God really keep his promises? God keeps his promises, but...

- not every promise in the book is necessarily ‘mine’
- how He fulfills them is often different than I want or expect
- in His time (not mine)
- some promises come with conditions
- His promises are all fulfilled in Christ

Perhaps the better question is not ‘Does God keep His promises?’ but ‘How does God keep His promises?’

His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises...
